- Take a deep breath
 - Remove anything unnecessary
 - Work your way back through the steps
 - Gradually add things back once you've ruled them out as the cause of trouble
(and, if that doesn't work)
 - Google any error messages you receive
 - Apply any found solutions with caution, particularly older ones or if you don't understand what the solution is doing
